

2021 Wrath Pinot Noir, Boekenoogen Vineyard Santa Lucia Highlands



Tasting Notes: We love the fruit from the high altitude Boekenoogen Vineyard, and we feel privileged to make wine with it. Wrath's 2021 Pinot Noir has complex layers of Bing cherry, loganberry jam and pomegranate that, with time, open up to display a broad array of spices (cloves and nutmeg). A lively palate, capped by dark berries, cranberries and minerals, displays bright acidity and a lengthy finish.
