2021 Wrath Pinot Noir, Lemoravo Vineyard Santa Lucia Highlands



Tasting Notes: Lemoravo Vineyard sits at 400 feet above the Salinas Valley floor, on the eastern slopes of the Santa Lucia Highlands. It is a small vineyard, only 28 acres, and is part of Kirk Williams' portfolio of properties. As a tribute to this land's history, the name is a threeword portmanteau as a tribute to its former crops: Lemons, Oranges and Avocados. This is Wrath's second bottling of Lemoravo Vineyard fruit. The wine begins with aromas of Ollalie blackberries and ripe strawberries with a hint of herbs and opens to flavors of blackberry balanced with more strawberry, rhubarb and spicy white peppercorn. The mouthfeel is juicy and bright with youthful acidity from its cold growing environment.
